DAVID ZEHNER wills his wrestling ability to Larry Alumbaugh, providing Larry doesn't drop any more weights on his foot.

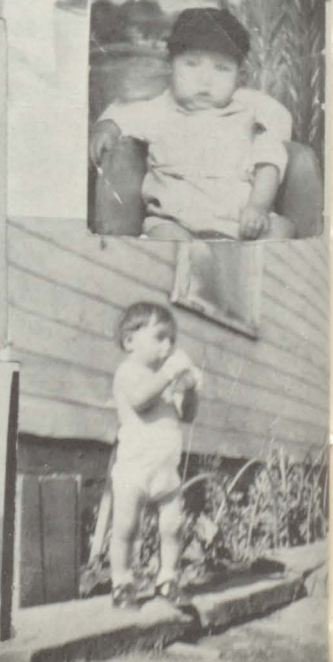
