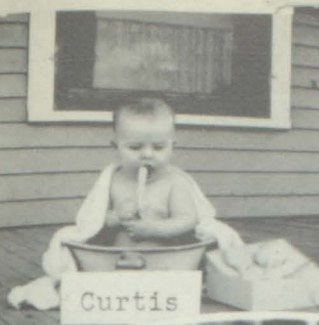
- I, John Sundberg, will my camera to the poor fellow that is the photographer of the '54 annual, providing that he uses it more than I have.
