There are certain experiences in our lives we will always remember and cherish. It is the sincere desire of your teachers that your high school experience will be one of these cherished memories.

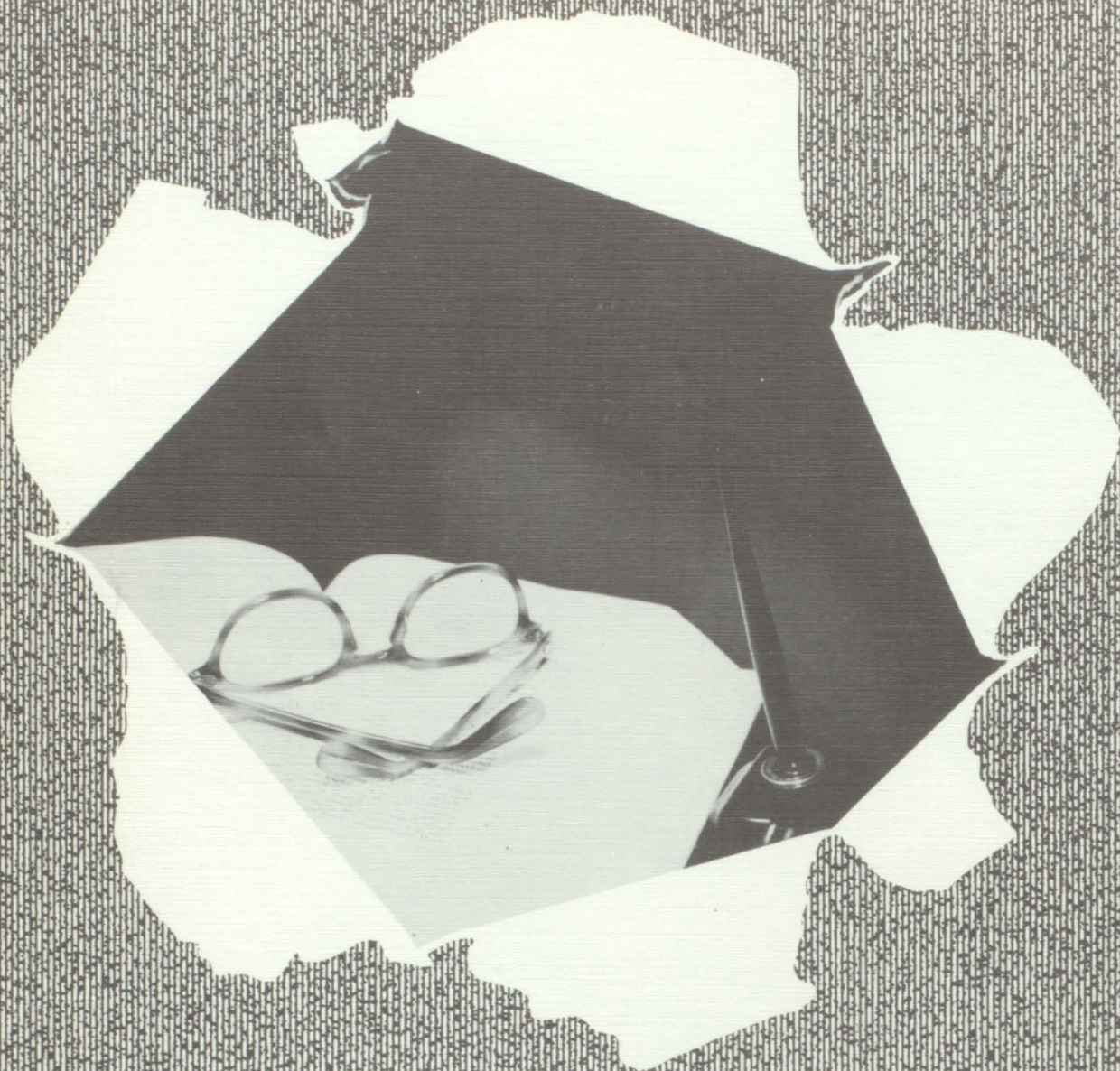

Yampa tried to keep pace, scoring 18 in the third and 16 in the fourth quarter. Final score of the game 78-54.



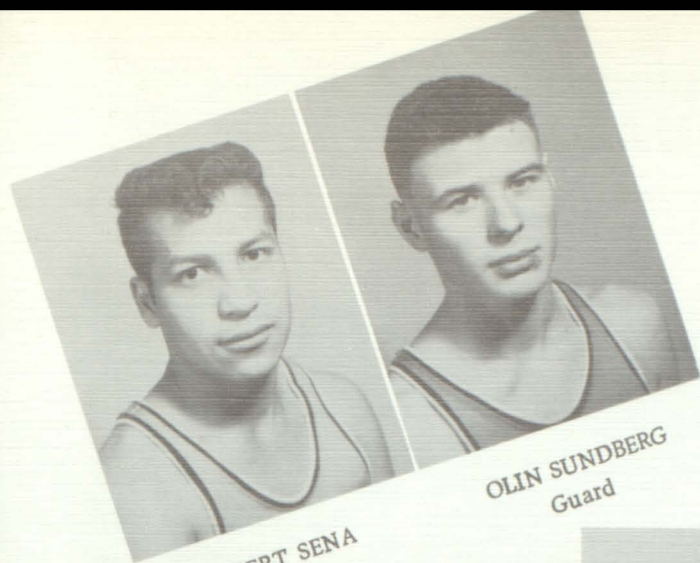
